- Providing quality assurance testing for online material
- Applying and adapting appropriate pedagogic strategies, techniques, and principles of instructional design into online courses
- Liaising with subject matter experts and the IT team throughout course development and implementation
- Developing course materials (e.g., handouts, videos, podcasts), learning objects, online activities, and group exercises including instructions and look and feel
- Creating course design templates and modular support materials as needed

- Researching and evaluating emerging instructional technologies and tools and make recommendations for use
